- The Candidate should also bring the following certificate, if applicable:
- (a) SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the standard format as specified in the PG Information Bulletin 2024) and should be in English or Hindi language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate. In case the certificate is in regional language the candidate should carry a translated copy of the certificate in English/ Hindi certified by a Gazetted Officer along with the original copy.
- (b) OBC-NCL certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. The OBC certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the PG Information Bulletin, 2024. In case the certificate is in regional language, the candidate should carry a translated copy of the certificate in English/ Hindi certified by a Gazetted Officer along with the original copy.
- (c) Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 and NMC Norms. No other certificate, issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be entertained. The format of Certificate of Disability is annexed (1, 2) in the Information Bulletin (For AIQ).
- (d) EWS Certificate as per the Central Govt. Norms (in the format as specified in the Information Bulletin) and should be in English or Hindi language. In case the certificate is in regional language the candidate should carry a translated copy of the certificate in English/ Hindi certified by a Gazetted Officer along with the original copy.
- (e) One Year Rural Posting Certificate & Annexure (If applicable).
- Certificates issued by the competent authority on standard format should be in English or Hindi language. Candidates are advised to carry certified (attested) Copy of English version of the original certificate, in case certificate issued is in regional language, along with original certificate.
- 3. A Softcopy (scanned copy of each document in .pdf format) to be kept ready with the candidates and to be submitted whenever required.
- 4. Candidates without original certificates/documents shall not be allowed to take admission.
- 5. Admitted candidates shall have to execute a bond agreement with the Govt. of Assam to compulsorily serve the Govt. of Assam or eligible agency notified by the department for a mandatory period of 2 years in the specified format.
